**Visual Arts Scholarship**  
**Completion Guidelines and Point Allocation Used for Scoring Application**

The maximum point accumulation is 100 per scholarship applicant. There is a minimum point accumulation required for a possible invitation to the interview process. The rationale for this policy is simply to place the scholarship award in high regard and to ensure that student applicants endeavor to complete all portions of the application. **INCOMPLETE OR ILLEGIBLE APPLICATIONS (Including Attachments) WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED!**

<b>Deadline (Postmark):</b>	February 2, 2009, with Award announced by May 1 <sup>st</sup> .
<b>Personal Information:</b>	All information must be complete. Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen or a Permanent Resident.
<b>Educational Information:</b>	All requested information must be complete. The N.W. Rotary Club of San Antonio Foundation <u>Visual Arts</u> scholarship program is available to students attending a college or university in the San Antonio area who are pursuing a degree in fine arts with emphasis in “visual arts.”
<b>Art Instructor / Professor Recommendation:</b>	<u>To be completed and signed by the student’s advising art instructor or professor. Application must be accompanied by the student’s most recent transcript of academic performance.</u> <b>Total Potential Point Value.... 25</b>
<b>Special Honors/Awards:</b>	Complete as appropriate. <b>Total Potential Point Value.....15</b>
<b>Student Activities (School):</b>	Complete as appropriate. <b>Total Potential Point Value.....5</b>
<b>Rotaract Club Member/Activity:</b>	Members of a university Rotaract Club (Rotary International Student Organization) are encouraged to apply for the scholarship. <b>Total Potential Point Value....10</b>
<b>Community Activities/Non-school:</b>	Complete as appropriate. <b>Total Potential Point Value.... 5</b>
<b>Work Experience:</b>	Complete as appropriate. <b>Total Potential Point Value.....5</b>
<b>Short Essay Requirements:</b>	Follow instructions carefully. <b>Total Potential Point Value....15</b>
<b>Personal Interview:</b>	At Rotary’s discretion, qualifying applicants might be required to submit to a personal interview. <b>Total Potential Point Value....20</b>
<b>Letter of Recommendation:</b>	Include one (1) letter of recommendation as noted on App.

- 2. How might this scholarship be helpful to you in meeting your goals?

X. Personal Interview (Possible 20 points)

At Rotary's discretion, applicants who meet the basic eligibility requirements might be invited for a short personal interview with the Scholarship Applicant Review Committee. Applicant's Personal Information (Page 1) is very important if it becomes necessary to initiate contact for interview or any other reason. Please ensure the information is complete!

XI. Letter of Recommendation

One (1) Letter of Recommendation **MUST** accompany this application. Preferably, the letter should be from a recent instructor and should (1) comment on some accomplishments cited in the Applicant's written resume and (2) the Applicant's potential in visual arts.
